Given the health and safety concerns regarding the coronavirus (COVID-19), auditorium seating availability may be limited, and meeting format may be changed to full remote via webcast. NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the South Coast AQMD is considering the adoption of Proposed Rule 1460 – Control of Particulate Emissions from Metal Recycling and Shredding Operations (PR 1460). The objective of PR 1460 is to minimize fugitive dust emissions from metal recycling and metal shredding facilities. PR 1460 will establish housekeeping, best management practices, registration, signage, and recordkeeping requirements

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that PR 1460 will not be submitted for inclusion into the State Implementation Plan.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that PR 1460 implement Sections 110, 172, and 189 of the Clean Air Act.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that a written analysis pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 40727.2 has been prepared that identifies all existing state and federal air pollution control requirements, all South Coast AQMD existing and proposed rules and regulations, and all air pollution control requirements that apply to the same equipment or source type as PR 1460.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Sections 15002(k) and 15061, the proposed project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3). A Notice of Exemption will be prepared pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15062, and if the proposed project is approved, the Notice of Exemption will be filed for posting with the State Clearinghouse of the Governor's Office of Planning and Research, and with the county clerks of Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, and San Bernardino Counties.
