<u>RE: Proposed Rule 1147.2 –</u> <u>NOx Reductions from Metal Melting and Heating Furnaces</u>

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing on the matter of adoption of rules and regulations for the South Coast Air Quality Management District (South Coast AQMD), or the amendments thereto, will be held on Friday, April 1, 2022 in the Dr. William A. Burke Auditorium at South Coast AQMD, 21865 Copley Drive, Diamond Bar, CA 91765, at 9:00 a.m., at which time evidence will be taken and all interested persons will be heard by the South Coast AQMD Governing Board. The meeting will be conducted through a hybrid format of in-person and/or virtual attendance via videoconferencing and by telephone with opportunities for public comment. Given the health and safety concerns regarding the coronavirus (COVID-19), auditorium seating availability may be limited, and meeting format may be changed to full remote via webcast. NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the South Coast AQMD is considering the adoption of Proposed Rule (PR) 1147.2. The objective of PR 1147.2 is to reduce nitrogen oxide (NOx) emissions and limit carbon monoxide (CO) emissions from metal melting, metal heat treating, metal heating, and metal forging furnaces that require a South Coast AQMD permit at Regional Clean Air Incentives Market (RECLAIM), former RECLAIM, and non-RECLAIM facilities. PR 1147.2 defines applicable equipment categories, updates NOx emission limits, and establishes a new CO limit. PR 1147.2 also includes compliance schedules with interim emission limits as well as provisions for monitoring, reporting, recordkeeping, and exemptions from specific provisions.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that PR 1147.2 will be submitted to the California Air Resources Board and the United States Environmental Protection Agency for inclusion into the State Implementation Plan.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the PR 1147.2 implements Sections 110, 172, and 182(e) of the Clean Air Act.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that a written analysis pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 40727.2 has been prepared that identifies all existing federal air pollution control requirements, all South Coast AQMD existing and proposed rules and regulations, and all pollution control requirements and guidelines that apply to the same equipment or source type as the rule proposed for adoption.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Sections 15002(k) and 15061, PR 1147.2 is exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3). A Notice of Exemption will be prepared pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15062, and if the proposed project is approved, the Notice of Exemption will be filed for posting with the State Clearinghouse of the Governor's Office of Planning and Research, and with the county clerks of Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside and San Bernardino counties.
